

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. Closing Date of Entries

Entries must be received no later than 4:30pm on 27 May 2011. Entries received after that date will not be accepted. Where classes are AOC, AC or AOV the colour and/or variety must be stated on the entry form. When 8 or more of a breed or colour have been entered into a class, an extra class will be provided. No phone or faxed entries accepted.

2. Entry Fees

\$3.00 first 15 entries & \$2.00 each subsequent entry. Entry fees must accompany the application for entry form and ARE NOT REFUNDABLE.

3. Prefix "J" is to be used for Junior Exhibitors

4. Entry Restrictions

It is anticipated that all entries received may be accepted. However, the Committee reserves the right to reduce the number of entries which may be accepted in any class or classes should there be insufficient penning space to accommodate all entries.

5. Health & Cleanliness of Exhibits

- Exhibitors are requested to ensure their exhibits are in good health and condition when delivered to the Poultry Pavilion. Exhibits showing signs of sickness, disease, vermin or poor condition may be refused acceptance.
- Exhibitors are requested to ensure that exhibits are clean by examining their birds for lice and vermin prior to delivery.
- Interstate exhibitors will be welcome, but they are asked to check with the appropriate government department in their home States in order to ascertain details of any special health regulations to be met before birds may be forwarded to or returned from the ACT.

6. Entry Acceptance

- No exhibit entered in a wrong class will be allowed to compete, and the entry fee in respect of such exhibit will be forfeited.
- The decision of the Judges shall be accepted as final.
- No trimming, plucking, dyeing of feathers, legs or any other fraudulent practice will be allowed, and every exhibitor will be deemed to be, and will be

held responsible for the condition in which his exhibit appears in the pen.

- All protests will be considered by the Committee as soon as possible after the lodgement, and their decision shall be final for this show.
- Whenever any exhibit has been disqualified the Committee may also disqualify the exhibitor thereof from exhibiting at future Shows of the Society and may declare forfeited all prizes awarded to him.
- Should any exhibit which has been awarded a prize be disqualified, the next in order of merit on the Judge's award card shall not necessarily be entitled to the prize, but the matter shall be determined by the Committee.
- No bird other than an exhibit in respect of which application for entry has been accepted by the Society shall be brought onto the Showground by any exhibitor or other person except with the consent of the Chief Executive Officer.
- No bird other than an exhibit shall be displayed or exposed for sale on the Showground.
- An exhibitor must not cover his exhibit during the period the pavilion is open to the public.
- Birds may only be removed for photographing with the approval of the Chief Steward or Supervising Steward, who will appoint another steward to attend while the birds are being photographed.
- The Chief Steward or Assistant Chief Steward may sanction the removal of birds from pens should the birds be required in the conducting of Judging Competitions

7. Arrival and Penning Dates

Exhibits must be penned no later than 8.30 am, Saturday 11 June 2011. Any exhibit not penned by that time will be refused entry into the Pavilion. Exhibits may be penned between 2.00pm and 9.00pm on Friday 10 June 2011.

8. Removal of Exhibits

Exhibits may not be removed from the Pavilion before 2.30pm on Sunday 12 June 2011, unless with the prior permission of the Chief Steward.

9. Awards

Ribbons for the Best of Breed Awards will only be presented if there are six or more entries in any one breed or colour.

10. Exhibit Unworthy of an Award

An exhibit shall not receive an award if, in the opinion of the Judge, it is unworthy of such an award.

11. Non-Exhibition of Exhibits

Exhibitors are requested to advise the Society by phone or letter at least 10 days prior to penning date, if any exhibits cannot be penned. This will assist in avoiding empty pens within classes.

12. Loss or Damage of Exhibits

The Society shall not be responsible in the event of any loss or damage to any exhibit howsoever arising, and in particular shall not be responsible if, through any negligent or wilful act on the part of any official or servant of the Society, or through theft, the exhibit is not restored in good order and condition to the exhibitor or any person claiming through the exhibitor at the close of the Show.

13. GST

All prize money includes GST.

14. Sale of Birds

The sale of any exhibit must be made through the RNCAS only. An additional charge of \$5.00 will be placed on each for sale card issued. "For Sale" tags will be provided by the Society and under no circumstances will any other "For Sale" notice be permitted. There will be no refunds on "For Sale" tags.

14. Prize Cards

Prize Cards will be awarded in the following way:

- Classes with entries less than six 1st & 2nd cards only
- Classes with six entries & over 1st, 2nd & 3rd cards

FEATURE BREED DORKING

It's purely British ancestry makes the Dorking one of the oldest domesticated fowls in lineage. A Roman writer described the Dorking type in AD45 and no doubt such birds were found in England by Julius Caesar. They are a quiet stately bird which matures slowly.

Their type is massive, long and deep with a stout beak. Comb is single or rose depending on colour. Their neck is short and well covered with hackle feathers. Legs are short and thighs are large. They have short round shanks. They have five toes. Rear toes must be separated and not joined.

They are a large meat white skinned table bird and lay a large white to tinted egg. They are very good mothers and can sit on 12-18 eggs.

The town of Dorking in England recently erected a large statue of a Dorking Cock in recognition of their association with the breed.

There are 5 recognised colours:

- Silver Grey
- Cuckoo
- White
- Red
- Dark

Their standard weights are:

- Cocks 4.55 6.35 kgs
- Hens 3.6 4.35 kgs
- Bantams Males 1190 1415 grams, Females 1020 1255 grams

Exhibits must be delivered no later than 9:00am, Saturday 11 June 2011. Any exhibit not delivered by that time will be refused entry into the Pavilion.

4. Judging of Open Egg Classes

Eggs will be judged on uniformity of size, shape, colour, shell texture and appearance. The judge has the right to examine contents.
